

Our vision is to provide a world-class Club experience that assures success is within reach of every young person who enters our doors, with all members on track to graduate from high school with a plan for the future, demonstrating good character and citizenship, and living a healthy lifestyle. We are able to execute our vision through our core beliefs: a safe place to learn and grow; ongoing relationships with caring, adult professionals; life-enhancing programs and character and leadership development experiences; hope and opportunity.



YOUNG PEOPLE WHO NEED US MOST

These youth benefit from trained, caring youth development professionals and volunteers who help them take control of their lives, envision productive futures, and reach their goals.

FORMULA FOR IMPACT

To make sure this happens, our Movement adopted the Formula for Impact, a theory of change that describes the experiences a Boys & Girls Club provides in order to increase our impact. A theory of change defines all the building blocks required to bring about a long-term goal or goals. It creates a commonly understood vision of how the goals will be achieved, and how to measure progress.

The Formula for Impact challenges all Boys & Girls Club professionals to work in a more holistic, intentional manner. It requires us to work toward common goals and start with our Club's mission in mind.





OUTCOME-DRIVEN CLUB EXPERIENCE

The Formula for Impact puts the true work of Clubs - the heart of what we do - right in the center. This is called the Outcome-Driven Club Experience. There are four components of successfully providing young people with an Outcome-Driven Club Experience.



Five Key Elements for Positive Youth Development

Research has demonstrated that the level of impact a Club has on young people depends on how often members participate and the degree to which the Club:

- Creates a safe, positive environment
- · Generates fun and fosters a sense of belonging
- Encourages supportive relationships with peers and adults
- Provides opportunities and expectations
- Offers recognition



Targeted Programs

Sequenced learning experiences with specific objectives for building skills and knowledge, organized into five Core Program Areas:

- Education
- Arts
- Leadership & Service
- Sports & Recreation
- Health & Wellness



These are targeted to help youth achieve positive outcomes in one or more of the Formula's three priority outcome areas: Academic Success, Good Character & Leadership, and Healthy Lifestyles



High-Yield Activities

These are hands-on, interactive, fun experiences that intentionally develop and reinforce core skills explicitly taught through targeted programs and help support our three priority outcome areas. They appeal to members' interests and their desire to play, and can even include some friendly competition. They motivate members to explore, develop, create, and learn. When done well, they remove the division between learning and playing.



Regular Attendance

When youth regularly attend the Club, our positive impact on young people deepens. We need to make sure they become members, attend often, and stay members as they grow up, especially through the critical teen years.



NOW IS THE TIME FOR CHANGE

Every day, 7.7 million kids and teens are alone and unsupervised after school.

Today, 11 of every 100 kids in South Hampton Roads will not graduate high school within four years, (Virginia Department of Education).

Many children in our community cannot even play outside because the threat of gang and drug-related violence is simply too high. Here in Virginia, studies show that students involved in gang activity are 17 times more likely to take a gun to school, five times more likely to attack someone to harm them, over four times as likely to be threatened or injured, and five times more likely to ever be suspended, (Virginia RULES).

Programs targeting social-emotional skills and learning have been shown to improve academic outcomes by 11%; cultivate overall well-being, improve interpersonal relationships with peers and educators, and decrease problem behaviors, (The Impact of Enhancing Students' Social and Emotional Learning: A Meta-Analysis of School-Based Universal Interventions).

WHY BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS?

At Boys & Girls Clubs of Southeast Virginia, we're changing these statistics and the future for children. Boys & Girls Clubs are a safe place to learn and grow – all while having fun. It is the place where great futures begin each and every day. In every community, boys and girls are left to find their own recreation and companionship in the streets. An increasing number of children are at home with no adult care or supervision. Young people need to know that someone cares about them. Boys & Girls Clubs offer that and more. Club programs and services promote and enhance the development of boys & girls by instilling a sense of competence, usefulness, belonging, and influence.

The best way to predict the future is to create it. At Boys & Girls Clubs of Southeast Virginia, we are creating a new and brighter future for thousands of young people. BGCSEVA is a comprehensive youth service organization operating in Chesapeake, Norfolk, Suffolk, Franklin, Virginia Beach, Portsmouth, and on the Eastern Shore. We help young people in grades K-12 to reach their full potential through a program of youth development that emphasizes career and academic preparedness, healthy lifestyles, and good character and citizenship. We have nine Clubs throughout our service area and are open each weekday after school from 3pm - 8pm and for extended hours during the summer. Our membership is approximately 2,000 strong and each day 260 kids come to our Club locations. Membership is open to all young people.






